## **FILLING IN THE LOGBOOK:**

- The logbook takes the form of a table, which consists of 18 columns and 12 rows on each double page.  
In addition, there are two lines for comments at the bottom of each page.
- At the top of each page there are suggested abbreviations for the entries to be made in the Urgency, Supervision, and Specialty and Anesthetic Technique section of the table. Further codes for procedures and definitions are provided in the pages at the back of the book.
