

Arab Board of Radiology and Imaging (ABRI) Registering for eIntegrity Radiology – Integrated Training Initiative (R-ITI) Basic Science Module

R-ITI Background

- The Radiology – Integrated Training Initiative (R-ITI) supports and enhances the learning of radiologists. It has been developed by the UK Royal College of Radiologists and Health Education England. The training offers ideal preparation for FRCR* and equivalent examinations. It is also suitable for qualified staff wishing to refresh their core knowledge.

R-ITI Basic Physics

- There are 92 sessions in the Basic Physics R-ITI module. The use of a variety of images, including X-rays, ultrasound video clips and 3D diagrams, creates greater spatial awareness and realism than textbook learning. Self-assessment exercises enable learners to check their understanding on key topics.

ABRI Requirement

- The Arab Board secretariat will receive reports & regular notifications on the usage of the site and **appropriate completion of all** the sessions.
- Each session is between 30-40 minutes. The expectation is that **ABRI trainees will take a minimum of 30 minutes to complete each specific session.**
- The programme is available online to ABRI trainees at a special discounted rate of £84 (usual price £120). This discount is only available if the module is purchased in one transaction and not via monthly or quarterly subscriptions.

Registering

This link will take you to the registration page where you should register your name, email address and address. You can then pay for the licence by either credit card or PayPal and your login details will be sent to you within 24 hours. The licence will give you access to R-ITI Basic Physics module for 12 months from the date of registration.
